GIANTS

In its rainforests, cloud forests, and savannahs, you'll also find rare primates like the purple-faced langur and the slender loris, as well as a variety of small carnivores, bats, and marine mammals such as blue whales and dolphins. Explore lush jungles, forest edges, and wetlands with expert guides and uncover the hidden world of these delicate creatures.
